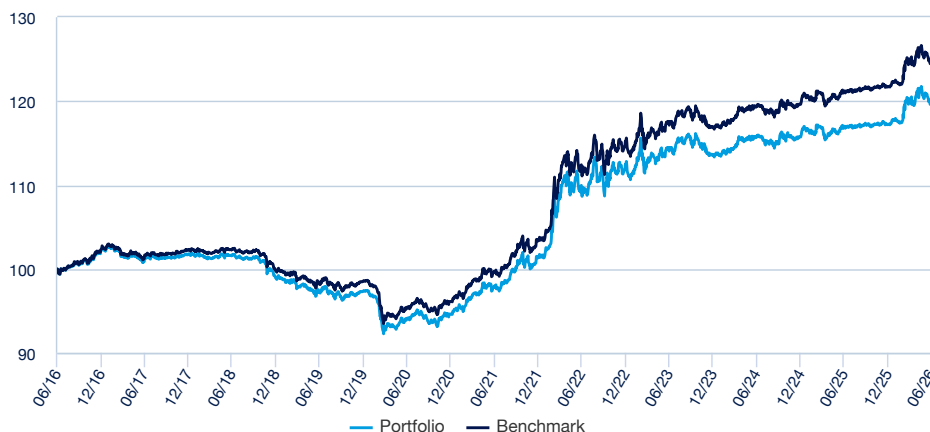

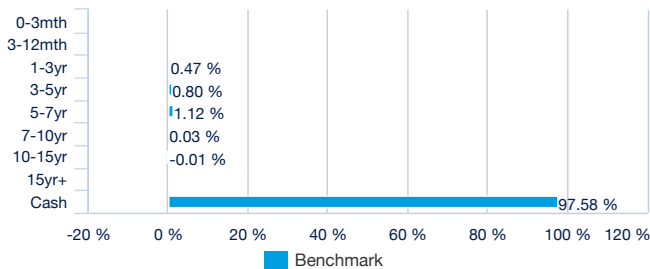

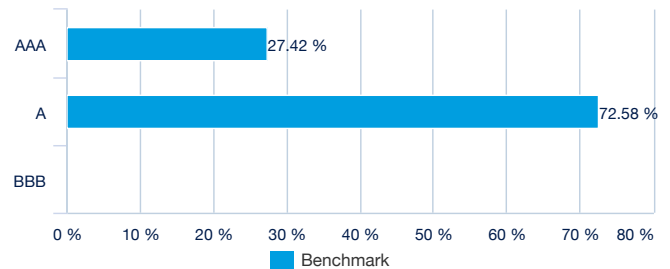

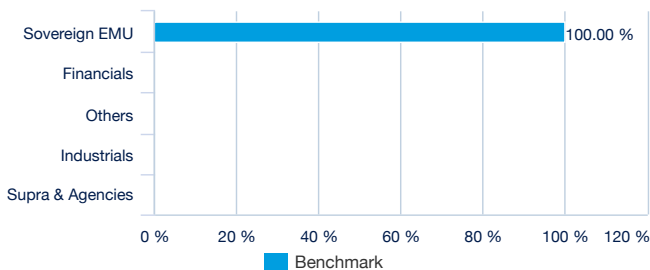
By maturity ETF (Long leg)



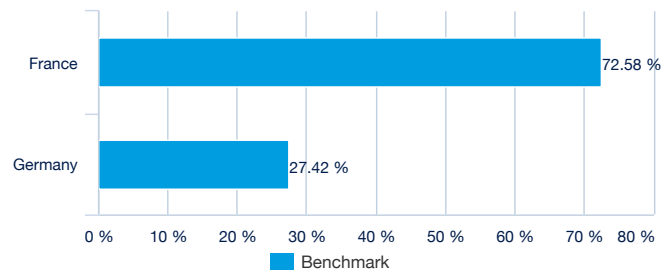
By rating (Long leg)
